duty of care, we require all staff, volunteers and contractors to have a current National Criminal History Check whilst volunteering and representing Inner West Neighbour Aid. As with any business reporting and auditing is a part of any business or organisation and I would like to assure our clients, clients families and volunteers that all our current staff, high school students have had a current "Police Check". Checks are conducted as required, every 3 years and volunteers will be requested and required to redo their check prior to the expiry of their outgoing check, in order to continue volunteering. Volunteers are also required to inform Inner West Neighbour Aid of circumstances that may effect their status. These discussions are a requirement and will be kept confidential.
